He finished 3rd overall a great acheivement in his first club national race.

Ella's first run of the day was recorded at 21.95 seconds, her 2nd run was much quicker taking 2.23 seconds off her first run coming in at 19.78 seconds placing her in 4th position. Ella tried really hard on her 3rd and final race of the day but finished just out side the top 3.

Day two saw a very determined Ella and she smashed it on all 3 races getting the overall Win

Justin Taylor-Tipton finished in overall 7th place with a personal best time of 16.55 seconds in the under 14's competition.

All team members who took part in the event improved performances over the weekend with some achieving persoanl best times.
